## A Versatile System That Will Fit Just About Anywhere.

Destiny Conferencing's standard 200 series models allow seating for four to 18 people and can be installed in any room of approximately 500 square feet. Multipurpose models have tables set away from the screen, which allows for sales presentations, training and general meeting use when a videoconference is not in session. "Plus" models provide room for additional seating in a raised back row. Customization is also available to accommodate specific needs.

Locations require a basic telephone connection and two 120-volt power plugs. From there, every aspect of getting the room connected, from working with IT and facility managers to ordering circuits from the local telecom company, is handled by Destiny Conferencing's installation team. Standard turn-time for manufacturing, installation and network connection is 60 days.

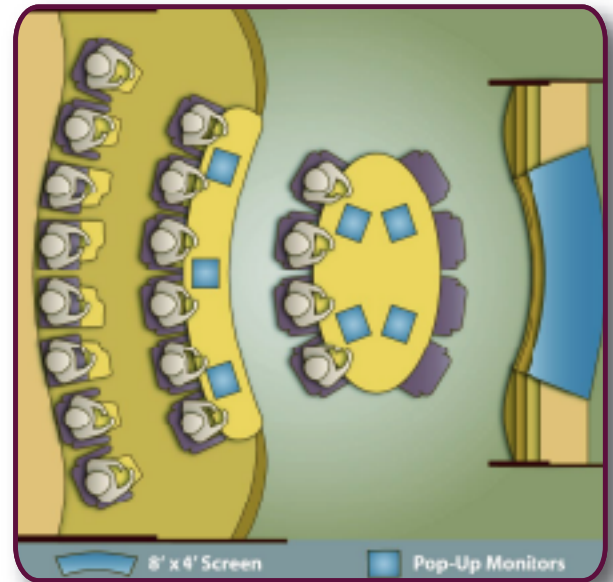

**210M+** □□□ The first digit indicates the number of 4'x4' high-resolution screens

**210M+** □□□ The second two numbers tell you how many people the room will accommodate at conference tables

**210M+** □□□ The letter M (multipurpose) following a model number means that the table is set away from the screen, allowing for the suite □□□ □ to be used as a traditional high-tech board room when a videoconference is not in session

**210M+** □□□ The + indicates that a back riser allows for additional seating
